NAPOLEON (15)
Ridley Scott, UK/USA 2023, AD, 157min

Ridley Scott (Gladiator) directs this spectacular epic detailing the rise and fall of the iconic French Emperor Napoleon Bonaparte (Joaquin Phoenix). With a stunning backdrop of large-scale filmmaking, Bonaparte's relentless journey to power, his volatile relationship with his love Empress Josephine, and his visionary military and political tactics are all laid out against some of the most dynamic practical battle sequences ever filmed. Michael Powell, UK 1945, 93mins

Headstrong Joan Webber (Wendy Hiller) sets off, wedding dress in tow, to marry a rich older man on his remote Hebridean island. Stranded on Mull thanks to the weather, Joan finds herself struggling against this unplanned turn of events. Disarming and enchanting in equal measures, this is a newly remastered re-release from Michael Powell and Emeric Pressburger.

Richard Curtis, UK 2003, 135mins

A special 20th anniversary re-release of this beloved comedy following nine intertwined stories about the complexities of love. In this Palme d'Or-winning psychological thriller, a celebrated writer is put on trial when her husband falls to his death from their secluded chalet. What starts as a murder investigation soon becomes a gripping journey into the depths of a destructive marriage.

THE ETERNAL DAUGHTER (15)
Joanna Hogg, UK 2022, AD, 96mins

An artist and her elderly mother (both played by Tilda Swinton) confront long-buried secrets when they return to a former family home, now a hotel haunted by its mysterious past. Alongside its gothic-laden imagery, Swinton gives a deeply moving performance in the latest film from acclaimed filmmaker Joanna Hogg, an atmospheric exploration of parental relationships and things left behind.

THE RED SHOES (PG)
Michael Powell, UK 1948, 135mins

In Powell and Pressburger's visually ravishing masterpiece, a young ballerina is torn between the demands of love and art. Like the heroine of Hans Christian Andersen's source fairytale, whose magic shoes compel her to dance, Victoria Page – played by real-life ballerina Moira Shearer – finds herself driven to breaking point by an obsessive Russian impresario when she's cast in his ballet, The Red Shoes.
