Yet his structured routine is slowly interrupted by unexpected encounters that force him to reconnect with his past. A sublime reflection on finding beauty in the everyday world around us.

COPA 71 (PG)
Rachel Ramsay, UK 2023, 93mins

Told by the pioneering women who participated in it and built from archives unseen for fifty years, this is the extraordinary story of the 1971 Women's Football World Cup, a tournament witnessed by record crowds that has been written out of sporting history — until now.

BOB MARLEY: ONE LOVE (12A)
Reinaldo Marcus Green, USA 2024, AD, 104mins

Kingsley Ben-Adir stars as the music legend Bob Marley in this powerful biopic of Marley's fight against adversity and the journey behind his revolutionary music. A true celebration of the life and music of an icon who inspired generations.

DUNE PT II (12A)
Denis Villeneuve, USA 2024, AD, 166mins

The mythic saga continues in the next chapter of Frank Herbert's celebrated novel, brought spectacularly to life with incredible, breathtaking visuals. Timothy Chalamet stars as Paul Atreides, on a warpath of revenge against the conspirators who destroyed his family. Facing a choice between the love of his life and the fate of the known universe, he endeavours to prevent a terrible future only he can foresee.

ROH MACMILLAN TRIPLE
Dances Concertantes, commissioned in 1955, was MacMillan's first major work. It is followed by Different Drummer, MacMillan's complex and haunting balletic interpretation of Woyzeck, Georg Büchner's play about a soldier's descent into madness. The mixed programme concludes with Requiem, his 1976 work for Stuttgart Ballet. 195mins tbc.




8th – 10th April
THE TASTE OF THINGS (12A)
Anh Hung Tran, France 2023, 135mins, subs

On a French country estate in the late 1800s, cook Eugenie (Juliette Binoche) has worked for the famous gourmet Dodin (Benoit Magimel) for 20 years. Bonding over a passion for gastronomy and mutual admiration, their relationship turns to romance, giving rise to delicious dishes that impress even the world's most illustrious chefs. But Eugenie is fond of her freedom and isn't keen on marrying Dodin. So, he decides to do what he's never done before: cook for her. A delectable feast for the senses, and a beautiful romance.

KUNG FU PANDA 4 (PG)
M Mitchell/S Stine, USA 2024, AD, 94mins

The world's most unlikely kung fu master returns with a hilarious new chapter in the beloved series of films. After three death-defying adventures defeating world-class villains, Po finds himself being called upon to become a spiritual leader, which poses a few problems: first, he doesn't know anything about spiritual leadership, and second, he needs to find and train his replacement as fast as possible.



12th, 14th & 16th April
NT LIVE: THE MOTIVE AND THE CUE (15)
Sam Mendes directs Johnny Flynn as Richard Burton and Mark Gatiss as John Gielgud in this fierce and funny new play. 1964: Richard Burton, newly married to Elizabeth Taylor, is to play Hamlet in a new Broadway production under John Gielgud's direction. But as they rehearse, two ages of theatre collide and their collaboration threatens to unravel. Filmed live at the National Theatre. 170 mins.



8th – 10th April
THE PROMISED LAND (15)
Nikolaj Arcel, Denmark 2023, 127mins, subs

A sweeping Nordic "Western" epic starring Mads Mikkelsen. In 1755, an impoverished Captain sets out to conquer the uninhabitable Danish heath in the name of the King. But the merciless ruler of the area believes the land belongs to him and swears revenge. Sprawling landscapes and an opulent period set design spectacularly capture an era rarely seen on screen.




21st, 23rd & 25th April
LES MISÉRABLES (12A)
Tom Hooper, UK/USA 2012, AD, 157mins

One of the most celebrated musicals of all time returns to cinema in a newly remixed and remastered version. Set against the backdrop of 19th-century France, and the buildup to a momentous rebellion against the authorities, Les Misérables tells the story of ex-prisoner Jean Valjean (Hugh Jackman) whose life changes forever when he agrees to care for the daughter of a factory worker (Anne Hathaway).



16th, 22nd & 25th April
JOHN SINGER SARGENT: FASHION AND SWAGGER
John Singer Sargent is known as the greatest portrait artist of his era. What made his 'swagger' portraits remarkable was his power over his sitters, what they wore and how they were presented to the audience. Filmed at Boston's Museum of Fine Arts and London's Tate Britain, alongside the 50 paintings in the Sargent exhibition sits stunning items of clothing and accessories worn by his subjects, drawing the audience into the artist's studio. Through interviews with curators, contemporary fashionistas and style influencers, this film examines how Sargent's unique practice has influenced modern art, culture and fashion, capturing an alluring truth with each brush stroke. 90mins. Amit Ravindernath Sharma, India 2024, 175mins, Hindi with Eng subs

A brand new Bollywood biopic telling the inspiring tale of football coach Syed Abdul Rahim, who between 1952 and 1962, helped the Indian football team to overcome countless challenges and obstacles to revolutionise the sport in India, and became an iconic figure in Indian sports history. 26th – 30th April
SPY x FAMILY CODE: WHITE (CERT TBC)
K Furuhashi, Japan 2023, 110mins, sub & dub

Loid (a spy) and Yor (an assassin) are oblivious to each other's secret identities as they pretend to be the perfect family, along with their adopted daughter Anya. While under the guise of taking his family on a weekend getaway, Loid's attempt to make progress on his current mission proves difficult when Anya mistakenly gets involved, triggering events that threaten world peace. Staying at number one for an entire month in Japan, this fun animation is perfect for newcomers to the series and a great introduction for newcomers too.

NY MET: LA RONDINE
Puccini's bittersweet love story makes a rare Met appearance, with soprano Angel Blue starring as the sophisticated French courtesan Magda, opposite tenor Jonathan Tetelman in his company debut as Ruggero. 170mins tbc.



11th, 12th & 15th April
THE NEW BOY (12A)
Warwick Thornton, AUS 2023, 96mins

Cate Blanchett stars in this 1940s set drama about a mysterious Aboriginal boy found wandering in the Australian outback, who disturbs the delicate balance of a remote monastery run by a renegade nun (Blanchett). Setting up a clash between his Indigenous spirituality and the Christian teachings of the monastery, it becomes a captivating story of spiritual struggle and the cost of survival.



26th April – 2nd May
CIVIL WAR (CERT TBC)
Alex Garland, USA 2024, AD, 109mins

From acclaimed director Alex Garland (Ex Machina, 28 Days Later), Kristen Dunst stars as a member of a group of military-embedded journalists attempting to cover the unthinkable as a civil war erupts in the United States. An exhilarating action film, and a smart look at the necessity of objective journalism, this breathtaking war film pits state against state in a country where nobody knows who to trust.

NT LIVE: NYE (15)
Michael Sheen plays Nye Bevan in a surreal and spectacular journey through the life and legacy of the man who transformed Britain's welfare state and created the NHS. Confronted with death, Aneurin 'Nye' Bevan's deepest memories lead him on a mind-bending journey back through his life; from childhood to mining underground, Parliament and fights with Churchill. Directed by Rufus Norris (Small Island), this epic new Welsh fantasia will be broadcast live from the National Theatre. 160mins tbc.

WICKED LITTLE LETTERS (15)
Thea Sharrock, UK 2023, AD, 100mins

It's the 1920s, and the inhabitants of a sleepy town are about to be drawn into a foul-mouthed mystery when Edith (Olivia Colman) starts to receive obscene letters. Although she immediately blames her much younger, ruder neighbour (Jesse Buckley), the local police believe something is amiss and, together with a group of resourceful women, endeavour to find who's really capable of spreading such filth around this harmless little seaside town... Also stars Timothy Spall.



3rd, 4th, 7th & 8th May
MONSTER (12A)
Hirokazu Kore-eda, Japan 2023, 127min, sub

When her young son starts to behave strangely, his mother feels that there is something wrong. Discovering that a teacher is responsible, she storms into the school demanding to know what's going on. But as the story unfolds through the eyes of mother, teacher and child, the truth gradually emerges. An incredible new film from one of Japan's most respected contemporary filmmakers, Hirokazu Kore-eda (Broker, Shoplifters).



24th & 29th April
ROH: SWAN LAKE
Tchaikovsky's sensational score combines with the evocative imagination of choreographer Liam Scarlett and designer John Macfarlane to heighten the dramatic paths of Marius Petipa and Lev Ivanov's quintessential ballet classic.
