Cyfansoddodd Rossini ei Offeren dros dri degawd ar ôl ei opera olaf. Cyfeiriodd at y gwaith annisgwyl hwn yn hwyr yn ei fywyd fel 'pechod fy henaint'. Nid oedd amser, fodd bynnag, wedi pylu ei ddisgleirdeb cerddorol - na'i ffraethineb. Er gwaethaf teitl y darn, nid yw'r *Petite Messe Solennelle* yn fach neu'n ddwys! Mae'n ddarn disglair, cyffrous, sy'n arddangos ysgrifennu corawl gwyth a dawn operatig ddigryffelyb Rossini.

Rossini composed his Mass over three decades after his final opera. 'A sin of my old age,' he called this unexpected product of his twilight years. Time, though, had not dulled his musical brilliance - nor his wit. Despite its title, the *Petite Messe Solennelle* is neither petite nor solemn! It is a radiant, thrilling piece, showcasing great choral writing and Rossini's inimitable operatic flair.

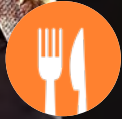

Sura, from a griot lineage, preserves West African traditions, while Mari reimagines Welsh mythology. Together, they highlight cultural identity, preserve language, and connect contemporary audiences with centuries-old storytelling traditions.

We're delighted to participate in Artes Mundi 11, the UK's leading biennial exhibition and international contemporary art prize presenting new and existing work from six of the world's most exciting international contemporary artists. This marks our first involvement, joining with four other major contemporary art venues across Wales.

At Aberystwyth, we will present solo exhibitions by two of the six shortlisted artists, Anawana Haloba and Sawangwongse Yawngwhe, comprising a selection of new and existing works of sculptural installation with sound and large-scale paintings respectively.

Solo exhibitions at other partner venues for AM11 are: Sancintya Mohini Simpson at Chapter, Cardiff;

Kameelah Janan Rasheed at Glynn Vivian Art Gallery, Swansea; and Jumana Emil Abboud and Antonio Paucar at Mostyn, Llandudno.

A group exhibition featuring all six artists will take place at National Museum Cardiff, the central hub of the project. This will reflect the core themes of each artist's practice and the exhibition as a whole - stories centred on traditions, migration, displacement and exile through histories of colonialism, conflict and consequent environmental legacies.

The winner of the £40,000 Artes Mundi 11 Prize and the recipient of the Derek Williams Trust Artes Mundi Purchase Prize will be announced in January 2026 during the exhibition.

A huge variety of genres, media and subjects characterise his work: abstracts, portraits, landscapes, still-lives, films of explosive, destructive/creative/mutational theatre, and a unique narration of subjects that include the Mabinogion, Welsh princes, literature, saints, and the historical challenges and political heroes of Wales.

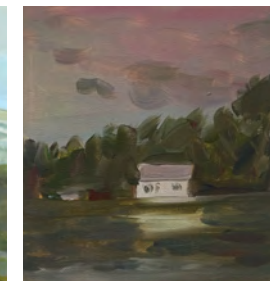

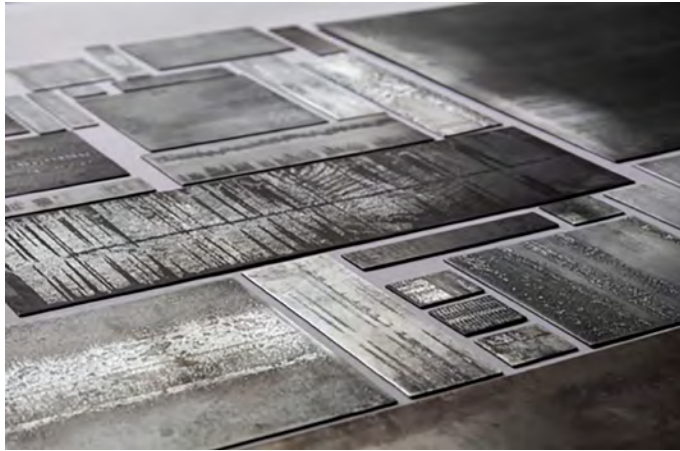

Examinations are available and provide a valuable measure of progress, though they are entirely optional and accessible for most students. Dance School pupils also have opportunities to showcase their progress in front of an audience.

We also run non-exam dance sessions such as Commercial Fusion, Adult Ballet, Prime Time Tappers, Musical Theatre, and more. These fun, energetic classes are perfect for those who want to enjoy dancing without the pressure of formal assessments.

Our Stage School and Youth Theatre provide professional actor training in a fun, inclusive, and supportive environment. These classes help develop skills in acting, dancing, and singing. Members can put their talents into practice through studio sharings and main stage performances, with the option to take examinations through LAMDA or Trinity College London.

We regularly invite professional companies and guest artists to deliver workshops and masterclasses, giving pupils the chance to explore new styles and techniques.

From *Frozen Jr.* and *Finding Nemo Jr.* to *A Christmas Carol* and *The Addams Family: Young@Part*, our recent productions have delighted audiences, proof that our young performers know how to put on a show!

With professional companies performing here throughout the year, pupils often have access to discounted tickets and exclusive workshops. Classes are available for ages 3 and up.

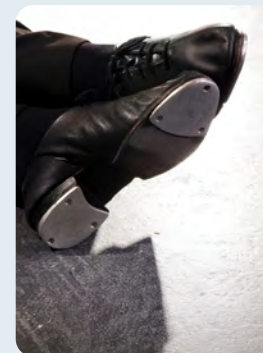
